



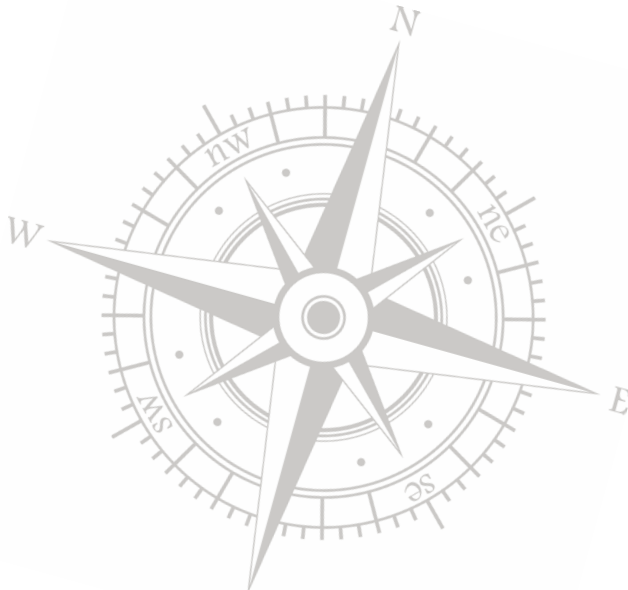

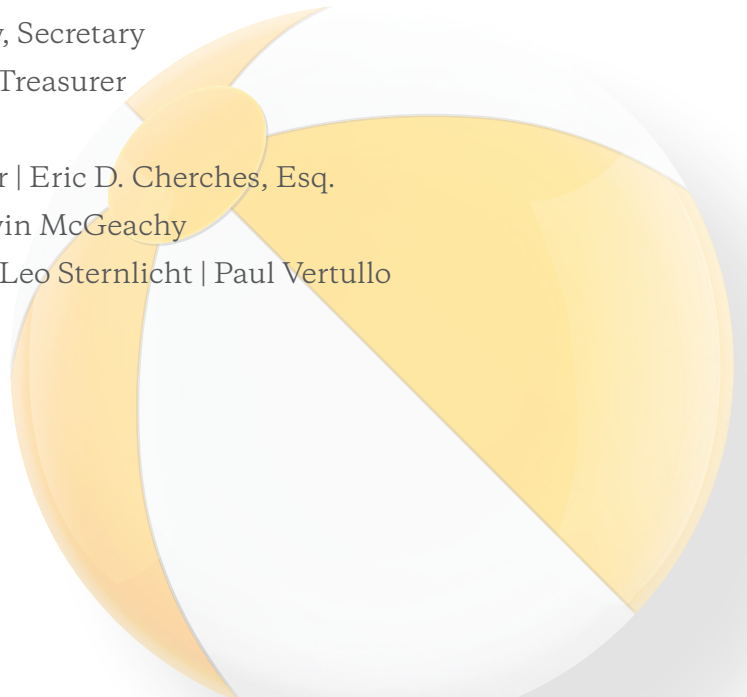

REDEFINING EMERGENCY CARE

Mather Hospital is redefining emergency care for our community. Our vision is to build a new Emergency Department (ED) that maximizes patient privacy and caregiver support, increases efficiencies, and incorporates best practices for patient and staff safety.

Caring for an aging population

Our population that is over age 65 continues to grow. Our vision is to create be a leader in age-friendly (older care) health care, which focuses on the four M’s: Mobility, Medication, Mentation, and What Matters Most to the Patient to increase quality of care. Taking these focuses into consideration we use a tailored approach to treatment based on each patient’s individual goals.

In the Emergency Department, this means building a larger ED that incorporates individual private treatment rooms with ample space for caregivers who frequently accompany our older patients. Our new ED will be approximately twice

the size of our current facility. The new ED will also have a split-flow design to accelerate treatment and discharge of patients with lower-acuity conditions and speed up hospital admissions for patients with higher-acuity conditions. Facilities using the split-flow operational model have significantly reduced patient waiting times, length of stay and the number of patients who leave without being examined.

Anticipating the unexpected

A separate entrance dedicated to EMS arrivals will allow for patients to be triaged quickly and improve the operational flow and eliminate bottle necks within the current structure of the ED. The new EMS entrance is closest to the critical care treatment areas. This section of the new ED will also have negative pressure isolation rooms which are best suited for patients suspected of having an airborne disease. This area will also have rooms for staff to safely put on and remove personal protective equipment.

The new Emergency Department will include space for dedicated X-ray, ultrasound and CT technology that will enable testing to be done more efficiently, saving critical time in the diagnosis and treatment of our patients.

Treating the whole patient

Mather Hospital has a long history of providing exceptional behavioral health services in both outpatient and inpatient environments. Our new ED will have a discrete dedicated area for patients suffering from a mental health crisis which will allow us to provide better care to this population with separate designated areas for adolescents and adults.

ABOUT OUR HONOREE

Kathryn B. Frey (Kathy) grew up in Setauket and was in the first graduating class of Ward Melville High School.

From her earliest years, Kathy's life centered around service to others. In the 1960s Kathy volunteered as a candy striper at Mather Hospital. When her children were growing up, the Frey family welcomed children from Northern Ireland to live in their home during the summer as part of the Project Children Summer Program.

Recognizing the importance of supporting the community, Kathy joined Mather Hospital's Board of Directors in December of 2005 and has been Secretary of the JTM Foundation Board since 2011. As hospital benefactors, the Frey's have supported many growth initiatives at Mather Hospital over the years and are leaders in the current campaign to transform health care locally through the building of a new Emergency Department, expand the surgery center footprint, enhancing outpatient behavioral health services, establish the new cardiac catheterization and electrophysiology lab, and renovating the main lobby.

In addition, Kathy is a member of the Board of Directors of Hope House Ministries, located in Port Jefferson, and has been a valued friend of Stony Brook University's Women's Leadership Council since its founding in 2014.

Through the Frey Family Foundation, Kathy and her husband Robert support local academic organizations including Stony Brook University



and Suffolk County Community College, including scholarships that focus on nontraditional students.

The Frey's are also longtime benefactors of local high school scholarships for graduates who have overcome significant personal challenges as well as those who have excellent records of academic and volunteer service. They are also benefactors of Math for America, the National Museum of Mathematics and the Alliance of Guardian Angels.

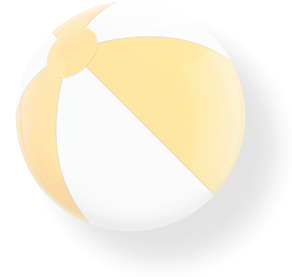
Above all Kathy adores her family, her husband Robert; son Michael and daughter-in-law Shannon; daughter Megan; and grandchildren Niko and Harper.

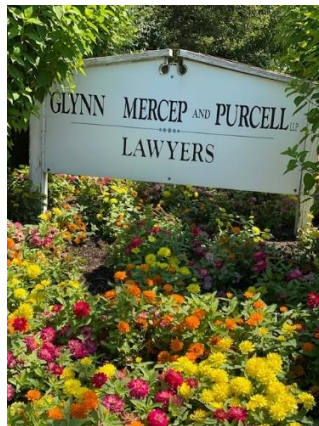

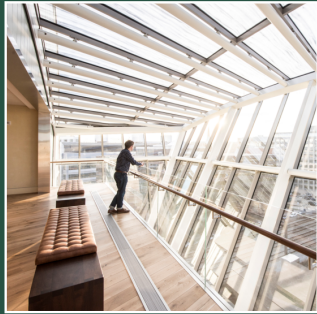
